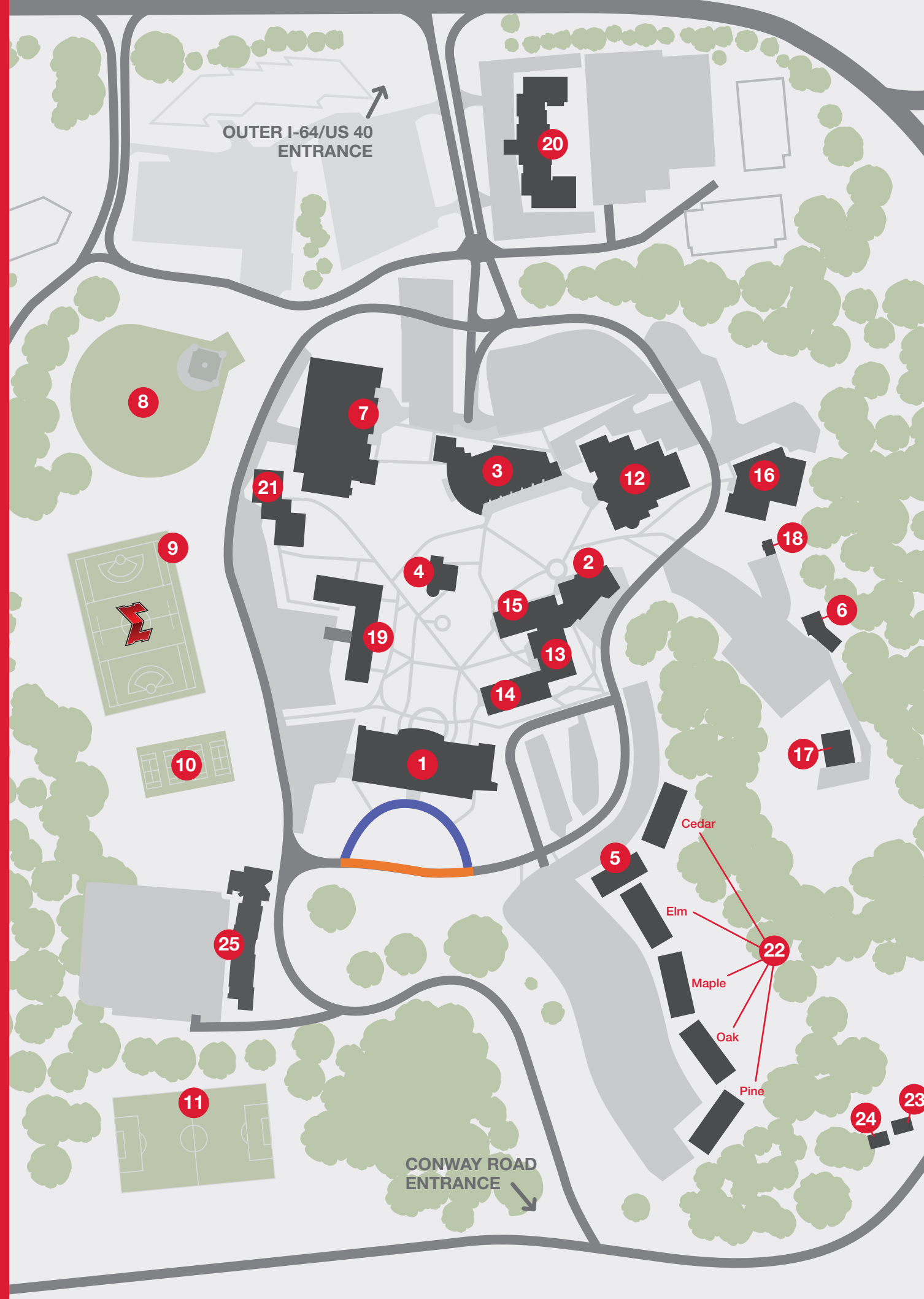
Maryville students may choose from more than 90 undergraduate, master's and doctoral degree programs in four schools and colleges:
