Student clinicians in Maryville's Communication Sciences and Disorders/Speech Language Pathology Program provide speech, language, voice, swallowing, hearing screenings, and treatment services. Student clinicians work under the direct supervision of faculty who are fully licensed by the State of Missouri and certified by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA).
