In addition to the 42 hours in Communication Sciences and Disorders, CMSD majors must take the required prerequisite and degree plan courses that are listed above. In some cases, students have the option of two courses (i.e. Physics 120 preferred or Chem 120.) Students need 128 hours in the following to graduate:

- 42 hours of Communication Sciences and Disorders Courses
- 9 hours of Health Professions Core Courses
- 11 hours of Science Courses (Biology, Chemistry/Physics)
- 6 hours of Psychology Core Courses
- 9 hours of Education Core Courses
- 30 hours of General Education Requirements
- 21 hours of electives which allows for minors in Education, Spanish, Psychology ...
