

## Classroom Spaces Remaining Open

Maryville will open a limited number of classrooms/spaces for faculty to use during this transition. Rather than using the technology in these spaces, we encourage you to set-up in these spaces with your laptops and/or iPads to conduct your recordings. The spaces remaining open are divided into the following categories.

- 1. Spaces for those who need extra support (laptops set up and support staff will be stationed nearby).
- 2. General spaces for faculty who just need a place to record (and don't require much support).
- 3. Specialty labs/spaces that should be used only by faculty in those areas. (ex. Science Labs)

Spaces will be cleaned frequently, and rooms not represented on the list will remain closed and inaccessible during this transition (note: they've already been cleaned).

If you anticipate needing to visit campus to conduct Zoom sessions, you should contact your Dean to inform of this requirement.
