

# Study Abroad - Summer 2023!

## All of our signature study abroad programs include:

### Dublin, Ireland

(3 weeks: June 1 - June 23)

- Housing in Ireland's most exciting city and exploring the beautiful countryside
- Excursions throughout Dublin plus day trips to Belfast and the Cliffs of Moher
- A required course from a local professor: *Irish History/Culture*
- A second course of your choice from a Maryville professor

**Program Cost: \$5,545\***



### Florence, Italy

(4 weeks: May 21 - June 22)

- Housing in the heart of Florence within walking distance of all important sites
- Excursions throughout Florence, plus day-trips to Venice, Siena, and Rome
- A required course from a local professor: *Florence and Its Contributions to Italian Life*
- A second course of your choice from a Maryville professor

**Program Cost: \$3,665\***



### London, England

(4 weeks: May 13 - June 10)

- Housing in one of the world's greatest city within easy reach of all important sites
- Excursions throughout London including the British Museum
- A required course from a local professor: (choose either *Business Practicum* or *British Life and Culture*)
- A second course of your choice from a Maryville professor

**Program Cost: \$5,770\***



### Oxford, England

(3 weeks: July 3 - July 25)

- Housing in the heart of the world's greatest university town within walking distance of all important sites
- Excursions to Windsor Castle, London, and Bath/Stonehenge or Stratford-on-Avon
- A required course from Oxford scholars (either *individual tutorial* or *Lectures on World Affairs*)
- A second course of your choice from a Maryville professor

**Program Cost: \$5,045\***
